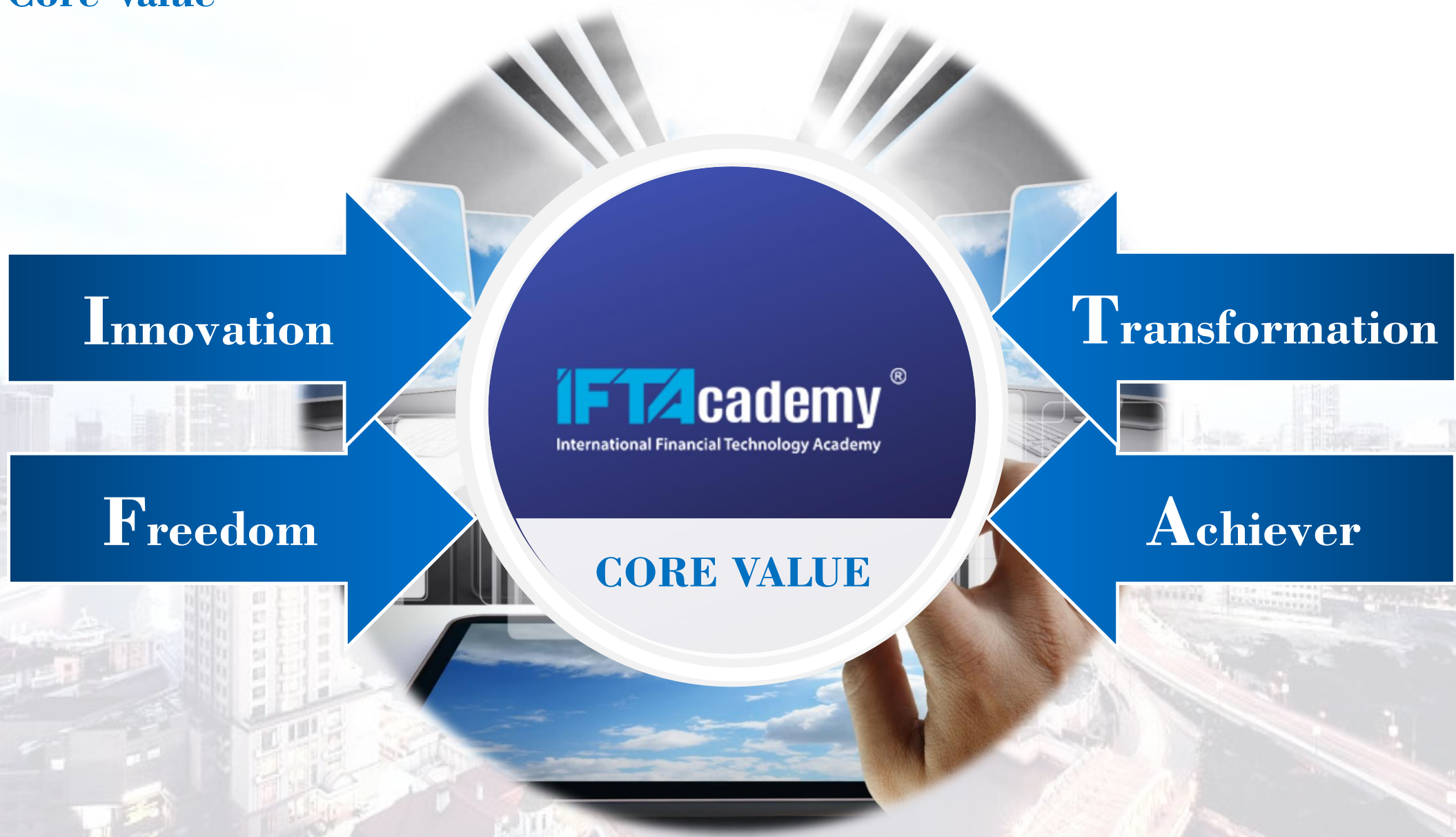

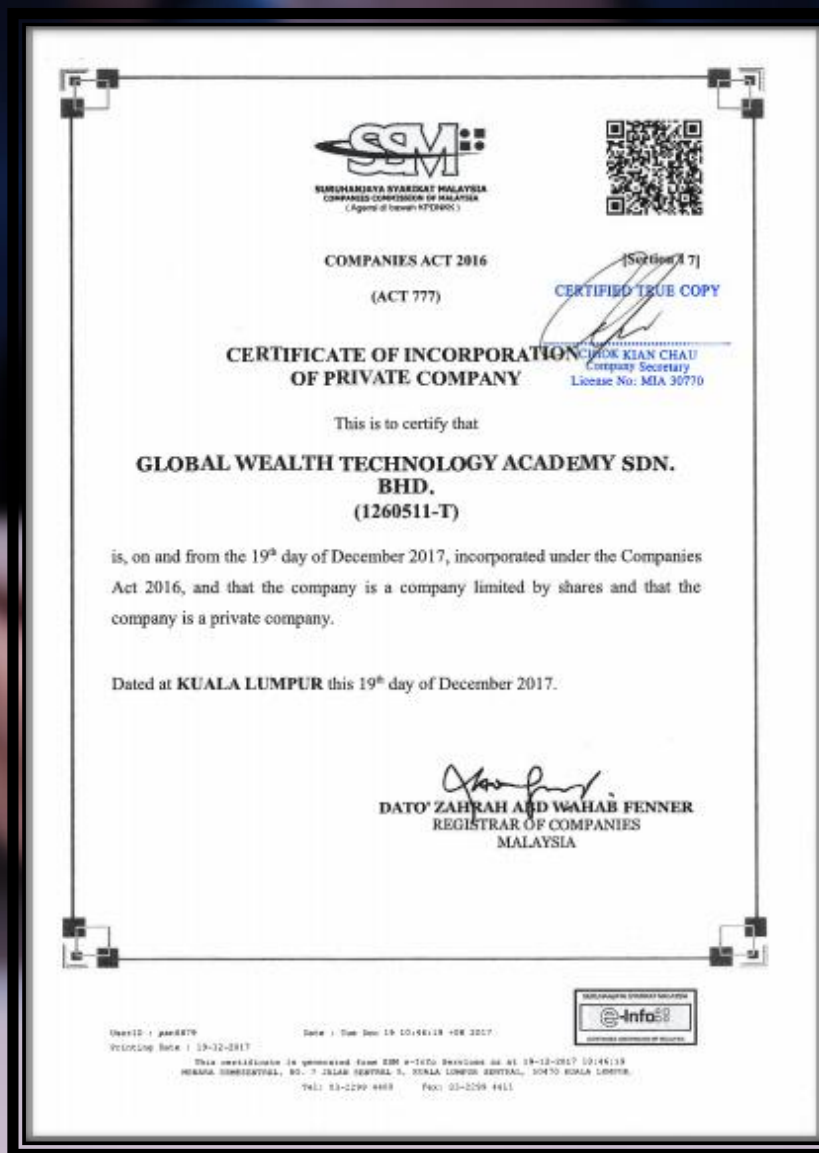

## **Who is HRD Corp Registered **Employer**?**

**Employers with 10 or more Malaysian employees are **COMPULSORY** to register with HRD Corp.**

**The monthly levy is charged at the rate of 1% of the monthly wages of Malaysian employees.**

**In return, the employers will receive financial assistance from the HRD levy paid, for training and development of their local employees.**





## **Who is HRD Corp Certified and Accredited **Trainer**?**

**Trainer refers to a Professional Trainer certified or accredited by HRD Corp.**

### **TTT Certified Trainers**

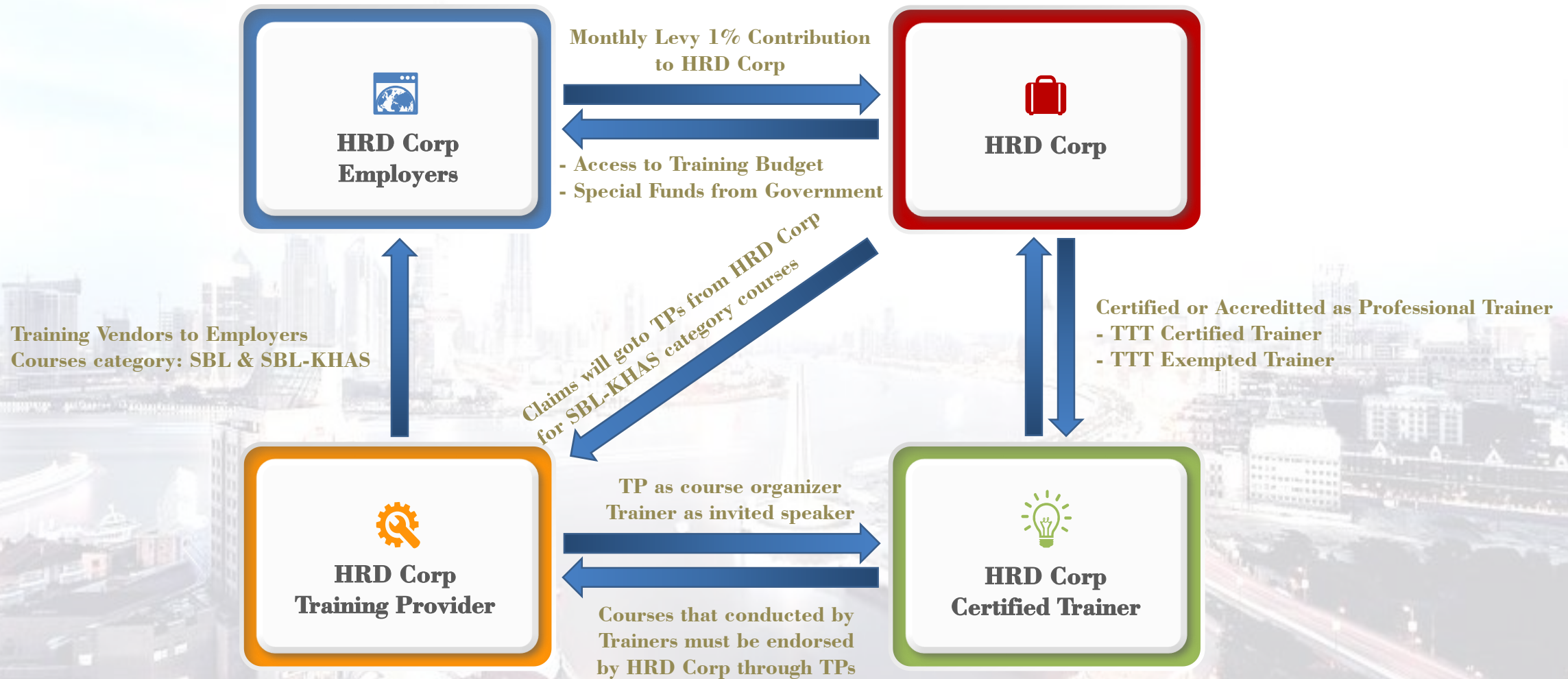
**Trainers who successfully completed the 5 days HRD Train-The-Trainer (TTT) certification course and certified by lead trainers are recognised as TTT Certified Trainers.**

### **TTT Exempted Trainers**

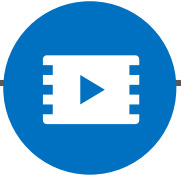
**Trainers who successfully obtained an exemption for the TTT course based on certification, qualification or experience are recognised as TTT Exempted Trainers.**

# Journal to New Employers (NON-HRD Corp Employers)



## Step 1: Compulsory or Optional

1. For Employers with 10 or more Malaysian employees, **COMPULSORY** registration with HRD Corp.  
**The monthly levy is 1% of the monthly wages of employees.**
2. For Employers less than 10 Malaysian employees, **OPTIONAL** registration with HRD Corp.  
**if they choose to register, the monthly levy is charged at the rate of 0.5% of the monthly wages of employees.**



## Step 2: Understand Expansion of PSMB ACT 2021

1. Go to <https://hrdcorp.gov.my/expansion-of-psmb-act-2001/>
2. Check list of covered industries
3. Supporting Documents Checklist For New Employers Registration.



## Step 3: New Registration

1. New Registration at <https://hrdcorp.gov.my/employer-2/>
2. Click on <REGISTRATION> button will direct you to online registration form.
3. Fill in Form 1 and attach all supporting documents.
4. Process will take about 7 working days.
5. Approval letter will be sent to registered email with User ID and Password to login eTRIS system.
6. Upon registration approval, email notification will state the liability date for levy payment.



Levy Payment to be made **NO** later than 15<sup>th</sup> date of the month.

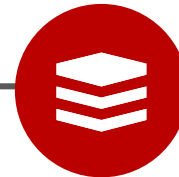
Eg: June Levy must be paid before 15<sup>th</sup> of July



## Levy Payment

- 1) Payment must be made via eTRIS System and Form2 e-slip shall be generated.
- 2) Payment method:  
Online (FPX or JomPAY) Bank Counter

Newly Registered Employer can apply grant after levy payment at least one month.



## Grant Application

- 1) Employer must apply the grant at least 7 days before commencement of training.
- 2) Approval must be obtained before training commencement's date.

Claims need to be submitted by employers after the approval of grants and training completion.



## Claim Application

- 1) E-Disbursement system can be accessed via eTRIS system.
- 2) Upon claim approval, payment will be reimbursed into Employer's account.
- 3) Training claims must be submitted within 6 months after training completion.

## Payable Fees by Employer

Soft Skills:

RM20,000 – RM5,000 = RM15,000

Hard Skills:

RM20,000 – RM6,000 = RM14,000

# Employer Grant - Scenario 2

## Claimable Grant Amount

Maximum RM700/pax/day,  
**Limited to an amount not exceeding**

Soft Skills:

Maximum RM5000/group/day

Hard Skills:

Maximum RM6000/group/day

## Course Fees

1 Day Course fees: RM 700

Total Course Fees:

8 X RM700 = RM5,600

## In House Training (Online)

Customised courses attended by  
employees from **ONE** organisation

## Number of Attendees

Soft Skills:

Maximum 35 trainees/group

Hard Skills:

Maximum 25 trainees/group

Minimum 1 pax/session

Scenario Example:

8 participants from a company

## Payable Fees by Employer

Soft Skills:

RM5,600 – RM5,000 = RM600

Hard Skills:

RM5,600 – RM6,000 = **-RM400**

**\*\*Employer do not pay any for Hard Skills Training\*\***

RM1000)  
= RM 11,000

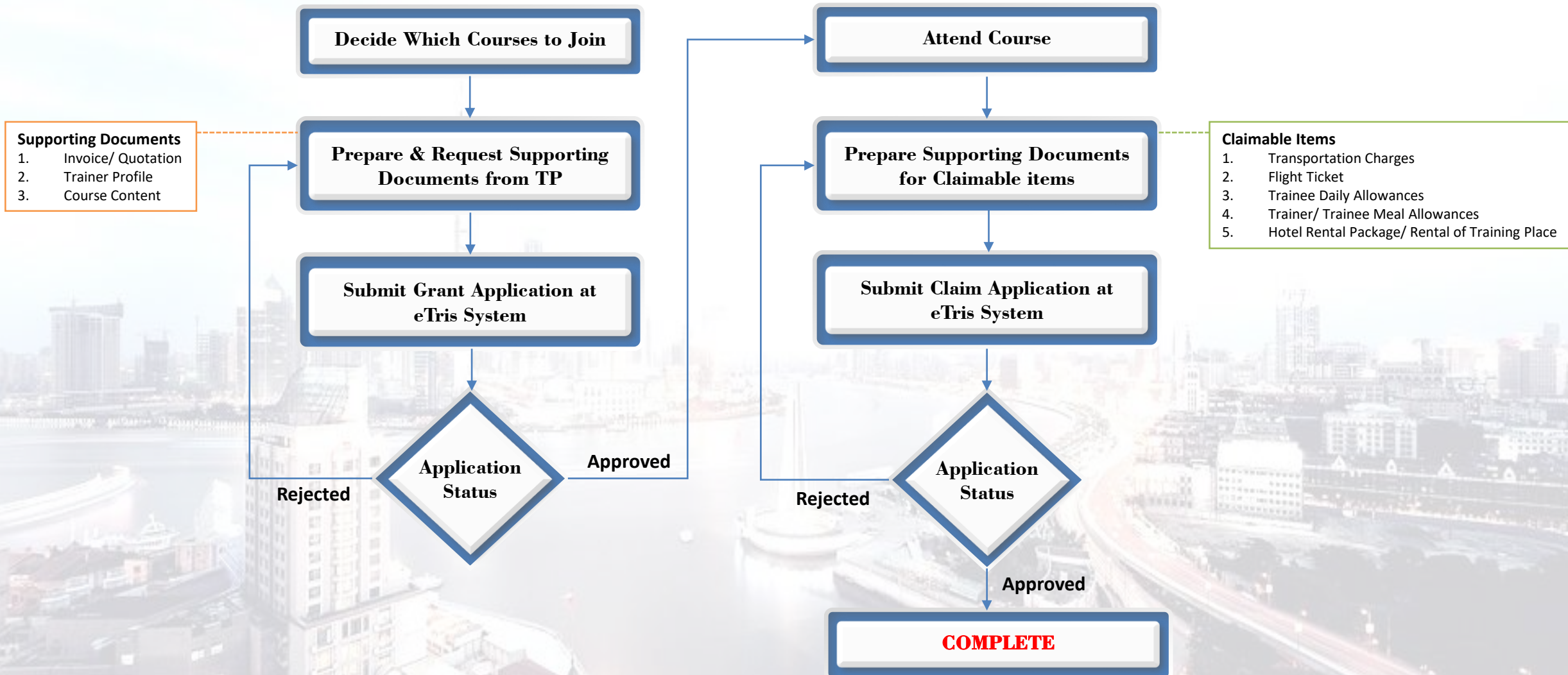
